

Eastover Uniform Policy & Chart



Eastover is a uniform school. Uniforms are a source of pride at Eastover, and we hope this brochure will assist you in clothing your child. Eastover Spirit Wear items may be purchased through our PTA Spirit Wear Committee. **Order forms are available on the PTA website or in the front office.** Simply complete an order form and send it to school along with payment. Your filled order will be delivered to your child within one week.

Students who arrive at school not in the official uniform will be outfitted with appropriate, gently worn clothes from the clothing closet. A notice will be sent home that day, indicating the child was not in uniform. Please do not subject your child to unnecessary delays in his/her classroom instruction time due to time spent resolving uniform issues. Repeat violations will result in a conference with the principal.

Some scholarship funds are available if you require assistance in purchasing uniforms for your child. Please contact the PTA Uniform Committee for a financial assistance application.

Additionally, the “Used Blues” committee offers gently worn uniform components for \$1. Please consider donating your wearable, but outgrown, uniforms to the school. If desired, you may also make a financial contribution to our uniform fund.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

- Local retailers that sell twill or official school uniforms include *Belk, Education Outfitters, Flynn O'Hara, J.C. Penney, Sears, Target & Wal-Mart*. *Lands' End* and *French Toast* are good on-line options.
- White polos may be worn with or without the Eastover logo. Logo polos are available through *Lands' End* and *Educational Outfitters*.
- Pants, capris and shorts are to be twill only. Corduroy, “parachute” or other nylon, denim, stretch knits and polyester are not acceptable materials.
- Cargo and zip-off pants and leggings are not official uniform components.
- Jewelry is to be kept at a minimum for safety reasons and to avoid distraction during the school day. Simple post or stud earrings and wristwatches are permissible. A simple necklace may be worn, but must be tucked under the student’s shirt at all times.
- Clogs, sandals, platform sneakers, sneaker skates and boots are not permitted.
- Navy blue sweaters and vests are a part of the official uniform; any other colors must be removed after entering the classrooms.
- Brand names and logos are not to be visible on any clothing.

Uniform Chart

To be in uniform, combine these components only. Different color outerwear should remain in the classroom unless students are going outside. Eastover T-Shirts and Sweatshirts may be purchased through the Spirit Wear committee.

All other items are available at your local retailers or on-line.

Uniform Component	How and/or when to wear
White short-sleeved or long-sleeved cotton knit polo shirt with or without Eastover logo.	Tuck into shorts, pants, skirts or skorts, or under jumpers
Plain white cotton knit long-sleeved turtleneck	Tuck into shorts, pants, skirts or skorts, or under jumpers
White t-shirt with block letter Eastover logo	On gym days only, tucked into shorts or sweat pants
Plain navy blue twill pants or capris, with inset pockets or without pockets (no patch or cargo pockets)	Shirt tucked into pants; 3 rd -5 th graders must wear brown leather belt if belt loops are present
Plain navy blue twill shorts, with inset pockets or without pockets. Shorts must extend at least 1” below the longest fingers on the child’s hand when arm is fully extended by child’s side, and can be no longer than knee length	Shirt tucked into pants; 3 rd -5 th graders must wear brown leather belt if belt loops are present
Plain or pleated navy blue cotton or poly/cotton skirt or skort. Hem must extend at least 1” below the longest fingers on the child’s hand when arm is fully extended by child’s side, and can be no longer than knee length	Shirt tucked into skort/skirt; 3 rd -5 th graders must wear brown leather belt if belt loops are present
Plain navy cotton or poly/cotton jumper. Hem must extend at least 1” below the longest fingers on the child’s hand when arm is fully extended by child’s side, and can be no longer than knee length	Worn with either uniform polo shirt or turtleneck under jumper
Navy or white sweatshirt with Eastover logo, or plain navy or white sweatshirt	On gym days or worn over uniform shirt on cool days
Navy blue or white cardigan or pullover sweater or vest.	Layer over uniform in cool weather
Braided, woven or plain brown belt	Required for all 3 rd – 5 th graders when wearing shorts, pants, skorts or skirts with belt loops. Optional for grades K-2.
Plain white, navy or black socks; white tights, or white footless tights for girls	With athletic shoes, Mary Janes or Toms.
Athletic shoes may be any color. Shoes may <u>not</u> have lights or any other items on them which may be deemed by school administration to be a disruption to the educational environment. Girls may wear brown, black, or navy Mary Janes or Toms. Boots <u>are not</u> permitted. On PE days, all students must wear athletic shoes.	With socks or tights
